Riding a school bus is a privilege. It is expected that students will behave themselves while on the bus. Violation of any of the rules may result in discipline that includes suspension or loss of bus privileges. Drivers will assign a seat to each student; the driver may also change the assigned seat at any time.

Parents: An authorized adult must be at the bus stop both A.M. and P.M. for students 3rd grade and under. Students will not be left alone or with an unauthorized adult.

School Bus Rules

1. Obey all reasonable request by the driver/monitor.
2. No standing or leaving the seat, especially when the bus is in motion.
3. NO fighting, hitting, teasing, and/or bullying other passengers.
4. Be respectful. Do not use indecent, vulgar and/or improper language.
5. No threatening gestures, language or behavior.
6. No disruptive behavior. Please use inside voice (not loud).
7. No use or possession of tobacco, alcohol or drugs.
8. No possession of weapons of any type.
9. No vandalism, graffiti or littering.
10. Arson and/or possession of lighters, matches or fireworks is Prohibited.
11. No discrimination or harassment of any type.
12. No gang activity.
13. Laser pointers are forbidden.
14. Eating and/or drinking are only allowed with permission of the driver.
15. Please follow the driver's instructions regarding activities that may cause bus ride to become unsafe for yourself or others.

Please remember the driver must be able to concentrate on traffic conditions and needs to be able to hear traffic outside of the bus.
